New Pre-Release Resource: MA Re-Entry Mediation



Am I prepared for release? Is my family prepared?

What do I expect when I get out? Do my family/others expect the same?

Do I have on-going problems around relationships, being a parent or recovery?

Do I have questions on support around where I'll live, work, transport?

What is my release really going to be like?



Let's talk about it!

If you are leaving the facility in less than 12 months you may be eligible

Pre-release re-entry mediation allows everyone a chance:

- To speak and be heard building better relationships
- To identify what needs to be worked out
- To solve problems together in a way that works for everyone
- The mediation process is <u>confidential</u>, <u>voluntary</u> and <u>free</u> and the mediators do not take sides or tell you what to do.

The confidential program is run by external agencies with the support of the DOC / Sheriff's Office.
